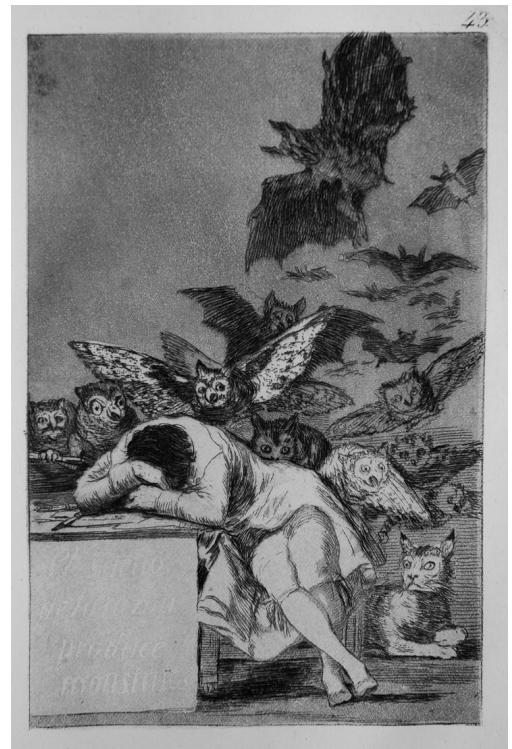

Karin Ruppeldt will talk about the movie Goya's Ghosts (2006) by Milos Forman - the acclaimed Czech/American film-maker. The film can be interpreted as an allegory centred around the Spanish Inquisition, whose persecutory ways can manifest at any time in any state or organisation. The story is told through Francisco Goya's eyes, who was a great artist of that era and portrayed ghostly images of people mistreated at the hands of the state. Multiple aspects of the concept of hauntology: personal, social, and ethical, will be explored.

Dr Karin Ruppeldt is a clinical psychologist and psychoanalytic psychotherapist. She emigrated with her family from former Czechoslovakia in 1997. She works in community mental health at Waitemata DHB and in private practice. She is trained in psychoanalytic psychotherapy and psychoanalysis both in her former country and in New Zealand. She is an NZIPP member.
