

Infant Observation Course

Deepen your understanding of infant development and inner world by directly observing infants in their home environment. Participate in small group discussions facilitated by experienced leaders, focusing on relationship patterns, early states of mind, and your own experience as an observer.

PREREQUISITES: Current New Zealand registration or equivalent overseas qualification, and professional training in the field. University/certified program students are also eligible. Applicants will undergo individual interviews to assess suitability and alignment with course objectives.
