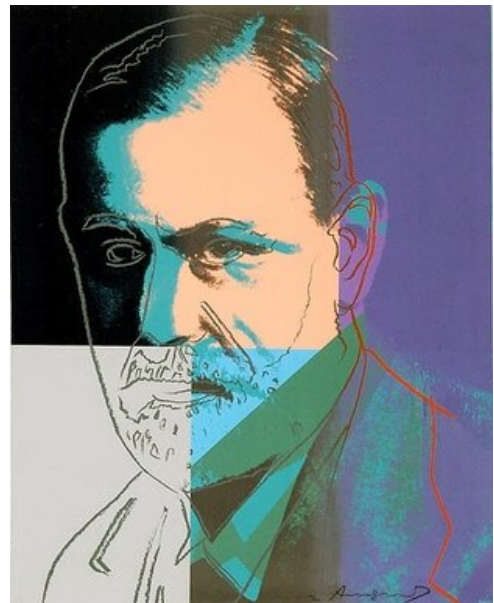
PSYCHOANALYTIC PSYCHOTHERAPY

DURATION: 3 years

PREREQUISITES: professional registration in the mental health field

COMPONENTS: theoretical seminars, twice weekly personal psychotherapy, weekly supervision, 2 training cases

COST: \$ 2500 per year



INFANT OBSERVATION



DURATION: 1 year

PREREQUISITES: those interested in deepening their understanding of children within the early relationship with parents/caregivers

COMPONENTS: infant observation, psychoanalytic theory, child development research

COST: \$ 650

CONCESSION FOR BOTH: \$ 3000 (year 1)
